1. Youth ages 14 and older from around the world are invited to participate.
2. We are looking for personal stories that encourage the reader to re-think a particular social stereotype. We want stories of justice, friendship, courage, patience, perseverance, kindness, forgiveness, humility, or sacrifice that help the reader question the fairness of categorizing and discriminating any social group or a person based on what we see in the media, social platforms or what we hear in our daily conversations.
3. By submitting, authors agree with the following SJC's Disclaimer for Submitters:

All submissions must be your original work. By submitting, authors warrant and represent that the work is their own. Authors will retain the copyright of their submissions. By providing original work, authors agree to allow and permit the Social Justice Club the right to print, publish, showcase, reproduce and distribute the submissions. The Social Justice Club reserves the right to incorporate and/or disseminate the submission in any form, including, but not limited to, in other publications, marketing, promotions, and other material both internal and external.

4. Limit of 1 story of up to 2000 words per person.
5. Work should be submitted as a Word document, in the following file formats: .doc or .docx
6. On the body of your email and at the top of your story, include: **your name, age, school name (if in school), city, and country where you are participating from.**

8. We will review the stories on a rolling basis. If yours is selected for publication, you will receive 100 US dollars.
